#### **Visitors Access**

ESA has an access procedure which requires you to show for verification an official government issued identification document. Vehicles and luggage may be subject to inspection by security staff when entering and exiting the site.

Always wear your Visitor's Badge visibly and return it at the end of your visit at the barriers or at the Gatehouse. Your badge is only valid for the days and location indicated. Unauthorised access to restricted areas is forbidden. Please follow all directions given by your host or the security personnel.

Audio recording, filming, or photographing, aerial or terrestrial of the ESTEC premises, the security installations and meetings are prohibited unless specifically approved. Privacy must be respected when taking pictures of individuals.

## Safety & Security

ESA's space activities require the use of hazardous materials and equipment. Therefore, hazard-warning signs must always be obeyed as well as the instructions received from your host.

While driving a vehicle you must adhere to the speed limit on site. In general, this is 30 km/hr.

Stop for pedestrians at crossings. They always have right of way.

Do not park on reserved parking spaces, roundabouts, or in non-parking areas if available. You can use the electrical charging stations in the parking area. As a courtesy to others, please move your vehicle when charging is completed.

Do not sigleave bags or personal belongings unattended. Unattended items may be removed and inspected by Security.

Report any lost items to security and to your ESTEC host immediately.

### **Environment**

While on site, all visitors are expected to ensure that their presence and activities do not have an adverse impact on the environment, either in our buildings or in their surroundings.

ESTEC buildings are smoke-free zones. Smoking is only allowed in the dedicated shelters.

Eating and drinking are only allowed in the restaurants and other dedicated areas.

## **Emergency Procedures**

In case of any type of emergency such as fire, accident or injury, call:

You will be asked to provide the following information: your name, location, the nature of the emergency and number of persons involved.

- In case of fire stop all activities, switch off equipment.
- Follow your host and leave the building by the nearest emergency exit.
- Do not stop to collect your personal belongings.
- Do not use the lifts. Use only the stairs.
- Report to the outside assembly point at the Escape football field or at Parking C from the Test centre.
