1. See the symbol of Madrid at Puerta del Sol and explore the old city

Go right to the heart of Madrid at Puerta del Sol, the old city square that is a constant hub of activity and the center of many of the city's celebrations, especially at Xmas Time



2. Taste your way around the San Miguel Market



Walk through the impressive Plaza Mayor on your way to one of the world's great food halls. The 100-year-old Mercado de San Miguel market sells more than just produce and is packed with tapas stalls.

3. Step inside the Royal Palace

Take a walk around the Royal Palace of Madrid, arguably the Spanish capital's most impressive building at almost twice the size of Versailles or Buckingham Palace.



4. Take in the atmosphere and history at Plaza de España

The huge Plaza de España is one of the most important squares in Madrid



5. See the sunset at the Temple of Debod



The seemingly out of place temple dating back to the 2nd century BCE was a gift from Egypt to Spain in 1968 after the country's help in saving the temples of Nubia. This is the perfect spot for a fantastic view of the Almudena Cathedral
